Candlelight Tours at Biltmore – The Details

For 2012, Lutheridge is offering, in partnership with the Biltmore Estate, the option to register for Christmas at Lutheridge and Biltmore and enjoy a candlelight tour. Here are the details regarding the Candlelight Tour versus the Daytime Tour.

Daytime Tour:

- This ticket includes a self-guided tour of the house during normal business hours as well as the gardens, winery, Antler Hill Village, and Riverbend Farm.
- Lutheridge will set up a timed entry for guests. This will be the time the guest can enter the house to do the self-guided tour. Timed entries are applicable to the house **only**.
- Lunch is on your own either at the Estate or in the nearby area.

Candlelight Tour:

- This ticket includes a self-guided tour of the house at night on Saturday night.
- Lutheridge will set up the timed entry for the guests. This will be the time the guests can enter the house to do the self-guided tour. Timed entries are applicable for the house only.
- The ticket also includes two options with regards to access to the estate during the day on Saturday OR Sunday.
 - The guest is able to tour the grounds ONLY (including Antler Hill Village, the gardens, Riverbend Farm, and winery) during the day on Saturday. However, guests are not able to enter the house for a self-guided tour during regular business hours on Saturday. In other words, guests cannot entry the house twice that day.
 - 2. Or if the guest wishes, he can go to the candlelight tour on Saturday evening and then return to the estate on Sunday to tour the grounds (including Antler Hill Village, the gardens, Riverbend Farm, and winery).
- Due to the timing of the candlelight tour, guests will need to handle dinner on their own either at the estate or in the nearby area.
